As a swimmer/parent of swimmer for Stonebrier at Sugarloaf, I will participate with the code of conduct as stated below:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow athletes, coaches, officials, parent volunteers and spectators.
2. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow team members and competitors.
3. Care and respect the equipment provided to me as part of my participation on the team.
4. Be candid and honest with my coach concerning illness and injury and my ability to train fully within the team requirements; including my level of commitment to the team and availability for swim meets and practices.
5. Conduct myself in a professional sportsman-like manner relating to language, manner, temper and punctuality.
6. Maintain high personal behavior standards at all times as a representative of the Stonebrier Stingrays.
7. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the coaches, officials and parent volunteers making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
8. Agree that inappropriate behavior can lead to my suspension from the team for the remainder of the season without refund of my fees paid.
9. Understand that if I am suspended from the team, I can return the following season under a probationary period. During this period a single offense may lead to my dismissal from the team.
10. Be honest in my attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for myself and my team.
11. Cooperate with coaches, parents and the Stingray Staff at all times.
12. Wear the team suit to all swim meets.
